



SABBATICAL CLARIFICATION & CALL COMMITTEE

Greetings! I was asked to submit a short note to the church members to diffuse some confusion and provide transparency on what is happening at Bethany and Lost Island Parishes. As many know, Pastor Peter's sabbatical has been in the works for the last 2 years. The plan was Pastor would take a 6-month sabbatical (April 14 – October 31, 2025) and agree to stay for at least one year after sabbatical leave was completed. Just like everything, plans can change. Due to recent events in civil rights to LBGTQ individuals, Pastor and his family have decided they can no longer stay in Iowa. What does this mean for Bethany and Lost Island churches? Bishop Lorna Haalas attended our joint council meeting, April 22. She encouraged the churches to start the paperwork process and form a call committee so when the time comes to replace Pastor Peter, we are ready to go. We are in a unique position, as normally the call procedure doesn't start till the pastor gives their 1 month notice that they are leaving. We are fortunate to start this process before pastor gives his notice. The call committee will consist of 2 representatives from Lost Island Church, and 3 individuals from Bethany Lutheran Church.

If you are interested in being on the call committee, please send your name and a brief reason WHY you'd like to be on the committee. Please send your request to Laure Miller 95 Nolan Dr. Emmetsburg or email ljaneane1215@gmail.com.

We would like requests by May 20, 2025, the date of our next council meeting. We plan to have this committee in place by June 1, 2025. This is a long process and will take commitment from those on this committee. Bishop Halaas told the councils this will take time and not to rush the process. She mentioned there are 20 -25 congregations in the Western Iowa Synod with pastoral needs. Good news, there were 18 newly ordained pastors in the Western Iowa Synod this past year, and 8 more in the process.

At this time Pastor has sent his information and areas of interest, Minnesota, to the synod office for review before being sent out. If Pastor accepts a new call during sabbatical, he has promised to come back early and stay for 3 weeks so all get the chance to wish him well on his next adventure.

Proverbs 16:3(ESV): "Commit your work to the Lord, and your plans will be established."

On May 4, Rogation Sunday, we pray for the Soil, Seed, Water, and Human Industry.

Genesis 2:15 (ESV): "The Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to work it and keep it."

On May 11, we pray for the graduates to go out into the world and be stewards of God.

Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope."

The biblical concept of stewardship is about managing everything God brings into the believers life In a manner that honors God and impacts eternity. It is defined as "Utilizing and managing all resources God provides for the glory of God and the betterment of His creation";.
