Stewardship January 2024

The beginning of the year is a popular time for personal reflection. Sometimes, when we take down the old calendar and hang up the new, we think about making a fresh start. New Year's resolutions are often focused on personal health — losing weight, relaxing more or smoking less. It is certainly important, of course, to take good care of our bodies. But Christianity offers us a fuller concept of self-improvement. St. Paul reminds us that both the body and the soul need an exercise program. In fact, every aspect of our persons — physical, mental, spiritual, emotional — can benefit from an annual self-examination. For example, one could join a Bible Study or prayer group, volunteer, altar guild, or help with the youth. Still, others use the three virtues - faith, hope and love - to guide their resolution-making process.
