

As I write this, we stand at the edge of September and are looking forward to ramping up all our activities that typically begin in the fall. Although the summer break was nice, I'm looking forward to getting going again because of all the energy that suddenly pops up when we get going again. I look forward to the energy of Wednesdays with it's Bible study and Youth activities; I look forward to having Vicar Jessie with us and seeing what that will bring.

One of the other things I would like to do this fall is begin a study on worship and why we do what we do, leading to training of some worship assistants. The word we often use in church circles for our order of worship is "Liturgy" which is a ten dollar church word that simply means "work of the people." Thus, when we gather for worship at whatever time, no one is a passive receiver, we are ALL participants in what happens, through the responses, our prayers and our singing together, and I can tell you from the standpoint of the one who stands behind the altar, those responses and that Liturgy that we create together is quite dynamic and often moving to be a part of. In this study, we will explore the different pieces of the liturgy and look at where they come from and what they mean. The ultimate aim of this is twofold; 1) deepen our understanding of this work of the people that we do together, and 2) develop a cadre of folks who are able to assist in the various parts of worship, to better express that this is a work that we do together. Classes will begin sometime this fall and are open to confirmed youth and adults who are interested. Watch for more news in the coming weeks.

I have made the very difficult decision to leave Papua New Guinea in June 2024. After my six-month home assignment (June-December 2023), I'll return to PNG for six

months to finish the 2023/2024 school year and then return to the US permanently. I've been struggling with burnout for several years and feel that this is the change that I need. While I feel a lot of peace about the decision, it will be very hard to leave such a wonderful music department, my friends, and the place that has been my home for most of my adult life.

I arrived in PNG nine years ago to begin serving as a missionary! I don't know what's next for me. but I hope to be a band director in Iowa or Minnesota so I can be closer to family. I would appreciate your prayers as I enter this season of transition. Please reach out to me if you have questions or words of encouragement.
