perience was that of seeing ourselves as a "teaching parish" and "learning laboratory. We have not had an opportunity to do that since, until this fall when Susan Rohan started her studies at Wartburg. Susan is not an intern in the same way that Sarah was, but as a distance learning student, she is using our parish as a field work site, and a place to explore various aspects of ministry and pastoral practice. Thus, it falls to us to dust off our learning lab skills to support Susan in her studies. She has already done some preaching. In the next few months, you will see her do more as she explores different types of preaching and different styles. We will be called to walk with her as she explores the exegetical work needed to develop a sermon, and also dips her toes into the water of how to do the sometimes difficult task of addressing current issues in the sermon. You will also see her assisting with worship in other ways, and doing some visitation as part of her learning as her journey progresses from stage to stage. She, or I, may ask you to provide specific feedback from time to time that focuses on the learning goals that Susan and the Seminary have identified. This flexibility and openness required to be a learning laboratory is one of this parish's greatest skills. It is also a great gift to the church as a whole. There will be questions, there may be bumps in the road, but I have every confidence we will do as good a job for Susan and any other intern for fieldwork student as we did for Sarah.

High School and Middle School Youth-those that are involved, we will start Mime Practice right after the 7pm service on March 1st.








