



A Difficult Topic: As you all know, the snow has been falling and we have had to make the decision to close the church on two occasions in February and already once in March. Attendance has been down in January and February as well, with an average of 40-50 people in church each week. Because of this our budget has suffered to a certain degree. We can pay the bills for now, but we are \$7,800 behind at the moment. What does that mean??? Currently the church has enough to pay the staff salaries and some of the bills. The snow removal fees totaled almost \$1,000 for February and \$500 for January. The utility bill has jumped \$65 per month. The list definitely goes on as to what is happening financially for the church. There is an urgent need to recoup from these hefty bills, but because of the weather it both increased the spending, and decreased the giving.

We ask that you prayerfully consider adding to your donation for the next few weeks and months so that the church can recuperate the losses and grow. Your staff would be happy to go without salaries, if not for their own pesky bills. And that really isn't the answer. The big round numbers of it are as follows: Currently we have donations totaling \$36,610 YTD and we need to be closer to \$45,717. We have missed two Sundays worth of income... We need to keep up on the bills. Prayerfully consider helping meet budgetary needs for Bethany. If you have questions/concerns for this need, please do not hesitate to talk with Susan, Parish Administrator on how you can help or to answer your financial questions.

Susan is working on ways to process EFT (Electronic) payments. Bear with her as she learns the Church Windows Program and works toward meeting this goal for Bethany. Hopefully soon she will be able to process EFT payments so that your donation can be made each week even without holding church services.


