

In April 2020, Bethany Lutheran/ Lost Island applied for and received a loan/ grant through the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) from a Paycheck Protection Program (PPP). This program was created to help businesses and non-profits who are 501(c)3 and 501 ( c ) 19 to help pay for payroll, health care benefits, utility and related costs over a 24 week time period during this Covid-19 pandemic. The program was provided thru Iowa Trust & Savings Bank. In total the Churches received \$20,102.75 to use as part of the PPP program.

How the program worked was we had to use those funds strictly for payroll, health care benefits, and utilities. In return, if we can show the bank that we used those funds appropriately, the \$20,102.75 would be forgiven and treated as a grant. If the churches would use some of those funds for other purposes, those other purpose funds would be considered a 1% loan with Iowa Trust & Savings that would be due on April 15, 2022.

Over the past 12 weeks, the Churches have used those funds in its entirety for the intended purposes stated in the PPP program. The Churches are waiting for the formal process to begin at the bank to show that the Churches used the funds appropriately and to turn this loan into a grant. I am hoping for this process to be finished within the next month. If you have any questions please forward them to Michael.



As we enter into this time of doing things differently, the stewardship board would like to let you know that the financial position of both churches is strong over all, but we need to remind you that though we are not able to meet face to face as a community of worship, we still have staff to pay, bills to pay and buildings to maintain. In order to remain financially sound we will need you to keep up your offering during this time. Offering for Bethany can be dropped off at the church, or mailed to the office. Offering for Lost Island should be mailed to Tim Nielsen.

If you need to adjust your offering because your work has changed, do not feel bad about doing so. If you need assistance during this time call Pastor Peter and he will get you connected with appropriate services. Thank you for all that you do to support our parishes’.



As of **August 23, 2020**, we will resume youth programs at Bethany on September 13<sup>th</sup> & September 16<sup>th</sup>.

**Note: This can change based on data and guidelines in Palo Alto County and direction from the Iowa Public Health Department as well as the local school district. Also, we will be assessing the risk of opening in a two week basis, if cases arise rapidly we will shut down in person youth programs and we will resume youth programs online via zoom, live or prerecorded videos.**

We want to be a resource and a place your youth feel safe coming to but also a group of people that can help them grow in faith daily.

Dear Parents of Bethany Youth,

We hope this letter finds you well. The last few months has been nothing but different as the COVID-19 Pandemic has shaken our everyday lives. We have been praying for you during this time that we have been apart.

We have been planning to reopen Bethany for youth programs with some limitations and expectations. The decision to reopen is one that must be taken with caution, safety, and change. As we begin to open the church back up for youth programs, the adjustments and recommendations listed below must be carried out, which are recommended by local health officials, the school district, and the Center of Disease Control (CDC), to maintain safety amongst all that join us.

As we return to in-person youth programs we want you to know that we care about everyone's safety. The things you can expect from us at Bethany, in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, will be:

- Taking extra measures to clean and sanitize all of church, especially the areas of high traffic.
- Cleaning high touch surfaces as much as possible and in between services and allowing extra time for the cleaning/disinfecting/sanitizing products to work at their best.
- The staff and volunteers are doing their best to maintain these procedures to minimize any spread of COVID-19.

The things we expect you to do for us as your youth come to any programs, in light of COVID-19 pandemic, will be:

- Stay home if you are sick or have any of the following symptoms
  - Symptoms of COVID-19 are fever, cough, loss of taste/smell, shortness of breath or difficult breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea.
- Maintain social distancing (6 ft)
  - Face coverings are highly recommended for all youth, such as a cloth mask. If your child does not have a face covering and would like one, we will provide one and launder it regularly.
- Help stop the spread of germs by carrying out good hygiene:
  - Wash your hands regularly. If not available use hand sanitizer.
  - Cough and/or sneeze into a tissue or your elbow.
  - Avoid touching your face.

To follow the guidelines given by health officials and the CDC this is how in-person youth programs will look differently:


- Sunday School;
  - Sunday, 9:30am-10:15am
  - Youth will enter/exit the single front entry door on the south side.
  - The youth will be asked to wear masks when entering/in/exiting the building and wash/sanitize their hands before heading to the basement. (All classes will be in the basement to spread all youth in a bigger space.)
  - All materials will be separated for youth so sharing is limited. All areas will also be disinfected after youth leave and before arriving.
  - Youth will exit the same way they entered unless staying for church, then they will make their way to the sanctuary.

*\*If possible, activities and lessons will be held outdoors.*

## CARPET FUND UPDATE

**FUNDS ARE STILL NEEDED TO FINISH THE CARPET PROJECT.** The carpet fund has received many nice donations in the past few months. There has been about \$15,000 designated to the project. We also have \$10,000 that we are planning to use from the deferred maintenance fund. The total bid is just short of \$27,000. As you can see we need about \$6,000 to get this project covered, if this is something you can help with please mail or drop off a check to the church with the designation of the carpet fund.
